Additional COVID-19 Safety Measures

- All persons over the age of 6 will wear face masks, helmets or racing balaclavas at all times whilst in the confines of the venue including within their awning/paddock area. Masks must always cover mouth and nose. Failure to wear a mask will result in escalating penalties of warning, formal warning and then any further transgression will result in removal from the event. Medical exemptions for wearing a mask will not be accepted. - These safety measures are in place until you leave the venue. Please keep masks on and adhere to social distancing until you have left the venue.
- Anyone showing any signs of high temperature, coughing or shortness of breath or any other symptoms of Covid-19 MUST NOT attend the circuit.
- There will be a curfew imposed on the event for 10pm and the paddock will be closed at 10pm. No attendees to be present in the paddock after 10pm. (if you are staying on site please ensure you are parked in the rear car park/grass area car park, you must be in your accommodation by 10pm)
- Each driver is permitted two attendees only with them at the circuit, who will need to be registered. This will be strictly adhered to and any additional personnel will be removed from the venue. No additional persons or spectators will be allowed into the Venue.
- Competitors are responsible for following his or her local government guidelines applicable to them & their local area at the time of the event.
- All attendees will be issued a wristband on arrival. The wristband will be valid for the whole weekend. Lost or broken wristbands will only be replaced on the basis that the wristband is re-presented to officials, Motorsport UK staff or those manning the gates.
- No social gatherings as per the UK Government [guidelines](#) in the paddock, within motorhomes/caravans during the weekend under any circumstance. Please do not mix households in social environments.
- No consumption of food or drink outside the awning. Smoking and vaping also prohibited in the paddock, please move to outside the confines of the venue.
- Two metre social distancing must be observed at all times, as should any 'one way' signage.
- Awnings must remain open whilst in use to allow maximum ventilation, this will be inspected by Motorsport UK to ensure it is of an acceptable level of ventilation. Awnings are permitted to be made secure overnight.
- Hand gel and personal PPE should be brought to the venue by the user – and disposed of in the correct manner. It is advised that each team should provide a sanitising station, readily available and located at the entrance/exit to the awning.
- Wash your hands thoroughly and as often as possible.

- The toilets are open but there will be no shower facilities available.
