### CHAMPIONSHIP BULLETIN: 01

The following changes are to be made to the official regulations already published for the above Championship and in accordance with Motorsport UK general regulation D11.1.3. & D11.1.4 the changes are to be implemented immediately.

**Reason:** Due to the Covid-19 Pandemic the original events could not be held on the dates published on the original Calendar

#### Revised Regulation:

1.4.2 The Championship Registration fee is;

1.4.2.1 for each Driver ~~£250~~; **£185 and includes a set of Le Cont Slick Tyres**

1.5.1 The 2020 British Short Circuit Gearbox Kart Championship will be contested **over-6 3** rounds. The dates are as follows:

1.5 The format for the Championship meetings will be confirmed in the Final Instructions and will usually be:

**Reason:** Clarification of Championship Scores

1.6.3.1 65 pts for 1st place, 62 pts for 2nd place, 60 pts for 3rd place, 59 points for 4th place, 58 points for 5th place, 57 pts for 6th place then reducing incrementally by single points to 29 33 pts for 34 30th position;

1.6.4.1 28 32 pts for 7th place, 27 31 pts for 8th place, 26 30 pts for 9th place then reducing to 1 point for 34 30th position;

1.6.4.4 in the case that there are more than 34 30 although less than 38 34 Drivers in the class there will be no Repechage;

(i) Championship Pre-Final points Championship Final points will be awarded according to the intermediate classification in respect of those final three Drivers; and

(ii) 28 32 pts for 35th place, 27 31 pts for 36th place, 26 30 pts for 37th place.

1.6.6.2 In the event of a tie for grid positions for the Pre-Final the higher finishing position from Timed Qualifying on that day for that round will take the higher grid position.

1.6.7 15 5 out of the available 18 7 scores maximum will count towards the overall Championship standings.



**Reason:** The Motorsport UK Challenge Trophy will not be contested in 2020 due to the revised calendar consisting of less rounds than the original calendar.

~~(i) drivers placed within the top 10 overall Championship standings will not qualify to contest the Challenge Trophy.~~

~~3.10.1 Each class will have two Heats, Repechage (if necessary), a Pre-Final and a Final.~~
