DRIVERS BRIEFING

- Firstly, welcome to the Whilton Mill and the 2020 MSUK BRITISH KART CHAMPIONSHIPS
- Attached are the Drivers Briefing notes no meeting or presentation will take place.
- The Race Centre will be on site, but social distancing and face coverings are mandatory, however it will not be possible to gather there. All results, notices and penalties will be available electronically online you should only visit if you have a specific question.
- The 'Officials of the Meeting' are listed in your Final Instructions.
- Nigel Edwards will be in overall charge of the event circuit wise (Race Director)
- Circuit 9 Marshals Post
- Circuit Pit Entry/Repair area is after Post H on the left slow speed please.
- Race format/Timetable refer to Final Instructions. Be aware there maybe gate 'opening' and 'closing' times.
- Race Starts Rolling Exit the pits, over the start line and complete one full lap to the
 race start. Slow speed from Post G, Yellow Flags at Post H/J (no overtaking) steady
 speed, stay in the corridors until the lights go out. Full circuit for all laps no short
 cuts.
- Standing Starts over the start line complete one full lap to the grid Square in the grid box Nose cone to the line wait for the lights Red Lights 1,2,3,4 all four lights on, when the lights go out this is the race start.
- N0 short cutting of the circuit at any time.
- A Digital Board at the Start/Finish will display normal start line signals, Warnings, Technical, Black etc



- 16 Circuit Cameras + Parc ferme camera's will be coordinated by the Race Director and the CCTV Official to resolve incidents.
- Quarter Flags if given please SLOW DOWN, SINGLE FILE, NO OVERTAKING. Continue around the circuit at a slow speed/single file until the GREEN FLAG is given on the Start Line indicating racing resumes (no overtaking before the line)
- If you see RED FLAGS Slow down and be prepared to STOP follow the official's instructions.
- RACE & RESPECT We ask that you work with us to provide a pleasant atmosphere for everyone to enjoy the event, this includes:
 FAIR PLAY, SELF CONTROL, & GOOD MANNERS.
 SIGNALING should be sensible and mainly for encouragement.
- KEEP ALL ACCESS ROADS CLEAR & ELECTRIC CABLES COVERED.
- PADDOCK PARKING CONSIDERATION FIRE EXTINGUISHERS ON DISPLAY AND IN DATE.
- NO BIKES/SCOOTERS.
- NO STARTING OF ENGINES.
- PLEASE FOLLOW ALL COVID 19 GUIDELINES ISSUED FOR THIS EVENT.
